THE ELLAMO FOUNDATION ETHICAL PRINCIPLES

Article 1.- Ethical Behavior

1. Respect for ethics will inspire the action of the organs of the Foundation Ellamo.
2. Ethical behavior involves diligence, good faith, and the primacy of the interests of the Ellamo Foundation and its people.

Article 2.- Respect the Legal Principles

1. Transparency and Accountability For the Ellamo Foundation, "Accountability" - transcends mere accountability and involves the social responsibility of accounting, financial and administrative information.
2. The Ellamo Foundation will be open and honest internally and in relationship with donors and members of the public. They will also undertake periodic accounting.
 - 2.a. The Ellamo Foundation will be transparent in all contacts with the Government, the public, donors, partners, beneficiaries, and other interested parties. Except for the personal affairs of their founders and persons. With whom they interact for all end in the same entity and the information that they define confidential in the various stages of the projects and actions of the entity.
 - 2.b. Basic financial information of the Ellamo Foundation, governance structure, the list of activities, founders and partners will be open and accessible to public scrutiny. The Ellamo Foundation undertakes to inform the public about its work and the origin and use of its resources. Ellamo will not grant access in the stage production and preparation that governs the appearance of CONFIDENTIALITY.
 - 2.c. The Ellamo Foundation will pay accounts and be responsible for their actions and decisions to:
agencies with suppliers of the fund,
governments, persons whom it serves,
with its staff and members,
partner organizations,
and the general public.
